2010 HIGHWAY CLEAN-UP

This year, due to adverse weather conditions, only 37 of the 70 clubs that registered were able to take part in Highway Clean-Up. Thank you to everyone who expressed an interest and a special thank you to the 788 participants who were able to complete the task.

You cleaned 441 kilometers of highway and filled 1,560 garbage bags. Thanks to the Department of Infrastructure and Transportation, \$12,007 was raised for 4-H this year.

The Highway Clean-Up campaign continues to increase environmental awareness in people of all ages and results in a cleaner Manitoba. Thank you all for the energy and effort you put into this program every year.

We encourage you and your club members to promote awareness of 2013 and encourage any 4-Hers, past and present to register as alumni and/or volunteer to work on one of the committees. (See form on page 8)




