



SAFE Committee Basics
(Brandon - Feb 14, Apr 6, 2017)

This interactive course covers duties and responsibilities of people in the workplace. Details regarding the role and function of the safety and health committee will be covered including procedures and requirements for meetings, hazard recognition and control, inspections and right to refuse scenarios. Setting up a well trained safety and health committee is the first step in achieving a good Safety and Health culture.

Prevention Basics
(Brandon - March 14, 2017)

The objective of the Prevention Basics workshop is to gain an appreciation of the importance of safety and an understanding of the basic components, strategies and key principles required to build a SAFE Work environment in your workplace.

Workplace Harassment & Violence Prevention
(Brandon - Apr 27, 2017)

Information for workers, supervisors, and employers to help create a workplace that is safe and respectful for all. In this course you will learn how to develop a harassment prevention policy and how to take a proactive approach to workplace violence utilizing a violence risk assessment. The assessment will then be used to develop a violence prevention policy.



Supervisors & SAFE Work

(Brandon - March 9, 2017)

(Dauphin - Apr 19, 2017)

This course is designed to assist Employers, Managers, Supervisors and others who are in charge of workers. Supervisors and SAFE Work covers the duties and responsibilities for those that supervise workers and work activities including topics such as hazard identification and control, investigations, due diligence, and right to refuse.

Hazard Identification & Risk Control

(Brandon - Feb 8, 2017)

This interactive workshop is divided into three sections: Spot the Hazard (Hazard Identification), Assess the Risk (Risk Assessment), and Find a Safer Way Every day (Risk Control). The course will emphasize different control measures such as elimination, substitution and engineering, and focus on developing SAFE Work Procedures.

Preventing Musculoskeletal Injuries (MSIs)

(Brandon - Feb 16, April 25, 2017)

This workshop explains how MSIs can develop (hazards and risks) and how to assess the risks, along with control measures that can be used to prevent these injuries. The workshop also reviews the requirements for developing an MSI prevention policy and examines how to engage your safety and health committee in preventing MSIs at your workplace.



Investigating Workplace Incidents (Brandon - March 15, 2017)

This course is an overview on how to conduct an incident investigation at your workplace. You will learn techniques for information gathering, interviewing witnesses, avoiding common causes arrived at by experienced investigators, recommending corrective actions, and preparing the report.
