- The personal skills necessary to participate well in a group.
- Behavioral maturity.
- Interest in pursuing an agricultural related career.
- Agree to report back to their school's student body and local Rotary Club.
- Agree to be available for local publicity.
- Indicate willingness to be billeted and participate in all events.

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION
