Aspiring Intermediate Members (AIM) Program August 5th to 10th, 2018 in Alberta

4-H Alberta has invited each province to send two 4-H intermediate members to their Aspiring Intermediate Members (AIM) program from August 5th to 10th, 2018 (dates to be confirmed). This 5-day program lets you sleep under the stars and choose your own path to discovery. The program will bring together 4-H members from across Alberta. Delegates, accompanied by a Manitoba chaperone, will be met at Edmonton airport and transported to the program. The Registration fee is \$300 payable to Manitoba 4-H Council Inc.

Communication, leadership and teamwork will continue to be a focus at this program however, during the week, members will work in a small group to hone a skill in their chosen area of interest.

Eligibility criteria (Manitoba):

- At least 12 years of age as of January 1, 2018 and no older than 14 years of age at the start of the trip
- Achieve in the 4-H year of travel application
- Completed at least two years in the 4-H program (i.e. be in 3rd year as a member).
- 4-H club fees paid to Manitoba 4-H Council.
- Members may apply, and be selected, to travel more than once in the same year (or in their 4-H career), however, priority will be given to members who have not travelled.

Eligible & Interested:

- Submit completed application form with photo by Friday, March 16th, 2018
- Prepare for an interview at either in person at Camp Arnes (if you are attending the 4-H Intermediate Overnight Event) or by phone.
- If selected, Registration Fee of \$300.00 is payable to the Manitoba 4-H Council Inc. on request.
