In January 2019, meet 4-H leaders, provincial directors and staff from across the country when we meet in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan! The conference is an opportunity to explore a variety of programs and topics of interest through all four of 4-H Canada's Leadership Development Pillars.

**Cost for the above opportunity**

- The registration fee covers the airline costs to and from the conferences, hotels, meals and conference activities.

**Chaperone for 4-H Canada Members Forum, Calgary - November 26 - 30, 2019**

One 4-H Manitoba leader will be selected to chaperone the seven 4-H Manitoba members attending this conference. The theme for the 2019 Forum will be announced on the 4-H Canada website. The chaperone must be at least 25 years of age and will be responsible for the health, safety and emotional well-being of the delegates, aged 16 to 21 years.

- The chaperone will participate as a staff member at the conference.
