#### RESOLUTION DECISION 2019

At the June 15 Board Meeting, the Directors reviewed the results of the voting on the Resolution presented to the membership in February. In a shortened form for ease of reading, the Resolution, votes and Board decision were:

Resolution #1 – Communications – that a two-person speech, without visuals, be added to each age category of Communications.

Votes: In favour – 14, Opposed – 13, Non-voters – 117

The Board respectfully **defeated** this Resolution after considering the following logistical details and impacts involved:

1. Potential for an additional 80 members at the event (240 v. 160 participants)
2. Requirement for additional volunteers (70 v. 50)
3. Venue
  - a. Larger venue with 4 additional breakout rooms which would possibly limit us to Winnipeg.
  - b. Completely change format of event to run all day and evening or over two days.
4. Budget – additional cost of \$7,200 for additional rooms, refreshments, tokens and awards (or more if became two-day event).
5. Historically two-person visual presentations have unfilled slots.

The Board did however, having reviewed the reduced impact of introducing potentially 40 new competitors, make the motion to introduce the Cloverbud category at the provincial level for a trial period of two years (2019-20 and 2020-21).
