### CALF SCRAMBLES

#### **General Rules and Regulations:**

1. Participation in the Calf Scramble is open to boys or girls who have demonstrated an interest in the production and feeding of cattle.
2. Winners in previous scrambles are not eligible to compete.
3. Contestants and alternates must reach their 14<sup>th</sup> but not their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before March 30, 2020.
4. Contestants must reside within one of the Manitoba agricultural areas.
5. "Agreement to Comply with Regulations" and "Minor's Release Form" shall be properly filled out and returned to the Provincial Exhibition Office not later than **February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020**.
6. **Once all entries have been received, the Fair Board office will draw for 20 contestants in each scramble. Those entries not drawn for their preferred evening will be offered the opportunity to participate in the alternate night scramble on a first come first serve basis.**
7. Once the contestants have been drawn for the scramble they will be notified by mail. Please wait for official confirmation and notice of contestant's acceptance from the Fair Board office, at which time contestants will receive necessary instructions. **If for any reason the contestant chosen is unable to participate, they must contact the Provincial Exhibition Office immediately so that an alternate can be notified. There will be a draw held from the remaining contestants.**
9. Calves to be used in the scramble will be uniform in weight.
10. There will be two (2) contestants per calf.
11. Each contestant will be supplied a number.
12. Contestants and calves will be placed in the arena as directed by the judges.
13. **Contestants will attempt to remove a halter from the calf. The contestant removing the halter will turn it into the judges, signaling a fair catch. If a contestant has hold of a calf, no one will be allowed to touch the calf until it breaks away.**
14. If a contestant catches a calf by the tail, s/he will be given a reasonable time to work around to its' head, otherwise the judge will order him/her to let the calf go.
18. The referees will not tolerate undue roughness. Poor sportsmanship automatically disqualifies a contestant.
19. All general rules of the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba will apply where applicable and are available at the office or online at [www.royalmanitobawinterfair.com](http://www.royalmanitobawinterfair.com) .
20. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba assumes neither responsibility nor liability for any accidents or injuries or personal loss or damage, which may be sustained in connection with the scramble.
21. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba states that it is mandatory that all contestants wear **CSA approved hockey helmets with cages** during the scramble. **Contestants must supply their own helmets.**
22. The winning ten contestants of the Monday night scramble will receive \$200.00 cash and the consolation contestants will receive \$100.00 cash.
23. The winning ten contestants of the Tuesday night scramble will receive \$200.00 cash and the consolation contestants will receive \$100.00 cash.
