I would like to take a moment to introduce myself, I am Kimberly Fargo Buchberger. I am the committee's acting youth ambassador for the World Clydesdale Show being held in July of 2021 right here in Brandon Manitoba. The committee had also appointed me the responsibility of organizing and raising funds for a charity of our choice.

Our committee has chosen Westman Dreams for Kids, a tremendous organization who grants hundreds of dreams to hundreds of deserving children and youth each and every year. My idea is to run a stick horse class, open to all the children in the building, four of the five days during the show. The class will be scheduled in between some of our regular scheduled classes in the main arena, Westoba Place. All proceeds will go to Westman Dreams for kids.

We also would like the 4H kids to have a bit of hands on back at the barns. We would need the bigger kids to team up with the younger ones of the group. But during their day at the show, we would like them to help organized them wagons and carts for the horses to get hooked to in a timely manner between classes. Each group coming to the show would spend one whole day at the show, and volunteer their time.
