
RIBBON BOOKMARKS

If you are looking for an easy gift idea for Valentine's Day or any holiday really, these ribbon bookmarks could be the perfect choice. Not only are they an easy sew project that can be done with a sewing machine or by hand, but they are cheap to make, too. You can whip up a bunch of these in just minutes.





- Decorative Ribbon at least 1/2 in. wide
- Elastic Hair Bands
- Decorative Buttons
- Scissors
- Needle & Thread and/or Sewing machine.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the ribbon into 18 inch strips. (This is for an average sized book. If you need a bookmark for a large book, you may want to measure around the book first and add length to the ribbon.)
- 2. Fold one end of the ribbon over 1/4 inch. Fold it over another 1/4 inch and stitch across. You can do this by hand or use a sewing machine.
- 3. Repeat for the other end of ribbon, adding the elastic hair band before you start folding to attach it to the ribbon.
- 4. Use your needle and thread to attach a button to the other end of the ribbon.
