



## Manitoba 4-H Council Inc. In-Person Activity & Event Requirements

**In order for your in-person 4-H activity/event to be covered by 4-H Insurance, the following must be adhered to**

- All federal and provincial health guidelines are met, or exceeded, with in-person programming
- It is required that each member family/leader attending has signed the waiver provided by 4-H Canada.
- It is required that each person attending be screened at every 4-H activity/event. (see below for screening questions).
- Only individually packaged, pre-prepared food and drink should be served.
- Washrooms must be disinfected regularly.
- Frequently touched surfaces must be disinfected regularly. Shared equipment must be cleaned/ disinfected after each use or it cannot be used.
- Your club must guarantee that the number of attendees does not exceed the maximum gathering numbers in effect at the time.
- Social Distancing must be adhered to at all times.
- Hand hygiene stations must be stationed at the entrance, exit and throughout the location.
- It is recommended that one entrance and one exit be specified so that contact is minimized.
- Wearing of masks is recommended
- Car-pooling is not recommended at this time.
- Make a list of all attendees and submit to Club Support Coordinator after event

### COVID-19 Screening Questions

**It is required that all participants be screened at every activity/event**

1. Are you experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell?
2. Have you traveled out of province within the last 14 days?
3. Have you traveled to a highly impacted area within Manitoba in the last 14 days?
4. Have you been diagnosed with Coronavirus/Covid-19 and not yet cleared as non-contagious by provincial or local public health authorities?
5. Have you been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of the Coronavirus/COVID-19?
6. Are you following all public health authority recommended guidelines and limiting your exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19?
