

Verbal Notice to All Attendees at 4-H In-Person Event

4-H is dedicated to providing a safe and inclusive environment that allows for universal access and participation. We are duty bound by the Code of Conduct for 4-H in Canada to do all that is reasonably necessary to protect youth in our community.

As part of providing a safe and healthy environment for youth to participate during in-person activities, 4-H is required to ensure all volunteers/participants/guests eligible for vaccination, to be fully vaccinated* against COVID-19, subject only to narrow exemptions under human rights legislation in order to attend this event.

4-H considers any misrepresentation or falsification of one's vaccination status at today's event as dishonest and a violation of the Code of Conduct for 4-H in Canada and may result in reportable offences.
