



## PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION OF MANITOBA CALF SCRAMBLES

Calf Scrambles ~ Monday March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**\*\*This is a fully immunized event, all participants must be able to show proof of vaccination and identification prior to consideration of registration. All Manitoba Health regulations shall be in effect throughout the event. Proof of age is required.**

### **General Rules and Regulations:**

1. Contestants and alternates **must reach their 14th but not their 16th birthday on or before April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.**
2. The "Standard Waiver for the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba" must be read, agreed to, and completed along with the online registration no later than March 10, 2022.
3. **Once all entries have been received, the Fair Board office will draw for 20 contestants in each scramble.**
4. Once the contestants have been drawn for the scramble they will be notified by email. Please wait for official confirmation and notice of contestant's acceptance from the Fair Board office, at which time contestants will receive necessary instructions. **If for any reason the contestant chosen is unable to participate, they must contact the Provincial Exhibition Office immediately so that an alternate can be notified. There will be a draw held from the remaining contestants.**
5. Calves to be used in the scramble will be uniform in weight.
6. There will be two (2) contestants per calf.
7. Each contestant will be supplied a number.
8. Contestants and calves will be placed in the arena as directed by the judges.
9. Contestants will attempt to remove the halter of the calf. The contestant removing the halter will turn them into the judges, signaling a fair catch. If a contestant has hold of a calf, no one will be allowed to touch the calf until it breaks away.
10. If a contestant catches a calf by the tail, s/he will be given a reasonable time to work around to its' head, otherwise the judge will order him/her to let the calf go.
11. The referees will not tolerate undue roughness. Poor sportsmanship automatically disqualifies a contestant.
12. All general rules of the Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba will apply where applicable. If you have any questions, the Cattle Show Chair, Dallas Johnston will be available to answer any questions during the event.
13. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba assumes neither responsibility nor liability for any accidents or injuries or personal loss or damage, which may be sustained in connection with the scramble.
14. The Provincial Exhibition of Manitoba states that it is mandatory that **all** contestants wear CSA approved **hockey helmets** with cages during the scramble. Contestants must supply their own helmets.
15. The winning ten contestants of the Monday night scramble will receive \$200.00 cash and the consolation contestants will receive \$100.00 cash.
16. The winning ten contestants of the Tuesday night scramble will receive \$200.00 cash and the consolation contestants will receive \$100.00 cash.
