4-H Bursaries

The Bursary awards are presented annually by the South Interlake 4-H Council to honour outstanding 4-H members. The recipient is selected based on their involvement in all aspects of the 4-H program at Club and South Interlake 4-H Area level.

One (1) bursary valued at \$500 each will be awarded annually, only if there are qualified applicants..

To be eligible to apply for this award, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- The 4-H member must be an adult member or leader up to 25 years of age as of January 1 of the current 4-H year and be enrolled in a postsecondary institution for the 2022- 2023 year
- was a member in the South Interlake Area in each of their high school years (grades 9-12)
- must currently be involved in the 4-H program as a member, leader, or volunteer
- Have achieved in each of their high school years (grades 9-12) (*Note: if you were unable to participate in 4-H in the 2020-21 year due to the COVID-19 virus, you are still eligible to apply. Please indicate this in section 11 of the application and ensure the questions are answered fully*)
- Have demonstrated a commitment to the 4-H program at both the Club and Area Council levels
- Previous recipients of this award are not eligible. Priority will be given to applicants who have not received the 4-H Bursary award out of high school

The Adult Bursary application must be returned to the chair of the Gold Watch/Bursary Selection Committee.
