Here's what you can expect:

Time Commitment

- One to two Zoom meetings each month between July and October in the evening.
- Attend SME October 14-16, 2022, in Brandon

Committee Responsibilities

The committee will work with the Program Coordinator to:

- Develop inclusive, educational and fun programming for the event.
 - This includes programming for Friday night, Saturday and Sunday.
 - This can include speakers, leadership-building activities, hands-on learning, games, etc.
 - Decide which project options are offered to members.
- Plan, organize, deliver and evaluate the event.
- Work within the event budget approved by M4HC.

Adult Members will:

- Enroll in their 4-H Club and pay their annual club fees
- Each lead an activity during the event.
- Model and encourage positive behavior.
- Encourage everyone to participate in activities.
- Participate in at least 75% of the meetings.
- Work with the other Adult Members and Senior Member Ambassadors to plan activities and share their progress with the committee.

If an Adult Member meets all these requirements, they will pay no event fees and will achieve their 2022-23 4-H project.

Would you like to be considered for this opportunity? Then send a cover letter and resume to me (lmcrae-walker@4h.mb.ca) by Friday, June 10th. The applications will be screened, and the four most suitable members will be chosen.

In your cover letter, be sure to share why you are interested in the opportunity as well as the skills and abilities you have that would be important in a position like this one. In your resume, be sure to include your 4-H experience, volunteer experience, experiences you've had in leading groups and activities with people of any age and anything else you think will show your suitability.
