- All 4-H Manitoba leaders and volunteers, and members who are age 18 before January 1 of the current 4-H year, are required to complete the Youth Protection Program (YPP) screening process. **Effective September 1, 2021, all Leaders must have YPP, Youth Safety at 4-H in Canada (Youth Safety) and Commit to Kids training to receive credit for the 4-H year.**
- 4-H Club meetings may occur in a variety of settings such as community halls, a leader's/parent's home and/or schools, etc. **Leaders are responsible to ensure the Rule of Two, being two fully screened Leaders at all times.**
- Manitoba 4-H Council Inc. purchases liability and accident insurance on behalf of enrolled 4-H members, Leaders and Volunteers.
- At various 4-H events, pictures are taken of activities for possible use on the 4-H website or in publications that promote 4-H. Photo releases are included on your enrollment form or on our website www.4h.mb.ca.
