

4-H Manitoba Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship Fund

Four scholarships are available to current and former 4-H members who will be between 18 and 30 years of age as of December 31, 2022. Applicants must have been enrolled as a 4-H Manitoba member for a minimum of five years.

- Applicants must submit a 450-500 word essay identifying an agricultural, environmental sustainability or general need within their community that they could use their education to help address.
- A short list of applicants will be selected for an interview.
- Receipt of any other 4-H Manitoba scholarship will not affect eligibility.
- Incomplete applications (e.g. name missing from pages or missing references) will be disqualified.
- Electronic applications will be accepted (receipt will be acknowledged by email).
- Paper applications MUST be postmarked to the Brandon Office no later than **Friday, February 17, 2023**

Applications will be graded as follows:

4-H Involvement 20% - Community Involvement 10% - References 10% - Essay 10%
Education/Career/Employment 10% - Interview 40%
