Walker receives 4-H scholarship

Oakbank resident Victoria Walker has been named an inaugural recipient of the McDonald's Canada Future of Agriculture 4-H Scholarship.

A Bachelor of Environmental Studies student at the University of Manitoba, Walker is one of eight national recipients and one of three Manitobans to be awarded \$5,000 bursary to support their goal of pursuing a future in the critical area of sustainable agriculture.

pringfield growth impacting **Sunrise**

While continued growth in Oakbank and Dugald is challenging the RM of Springfield to ensure the municipality has proper infrastructure, the Sunrise School Division needs accurate population forecasts to provide enough space for a growing student body.

Two new developments being planned for Dugald are cases in point. One, a 63lot development, has been

approved. Another much larger one is in the planning stages. Rossol Developments' design for 117 acres on Dugald's western edge includes multi-unit residential options, 76 two-unit lots and 250 single units. A 14.6-acre section will house 116,000 square feet of com-

mercial development. Those 402 units plus multi-family homes will bring hundreds of people into the area. They include students attending École Dugald and Springfield Collegiate.

Part of Rossol Developments' vice-president Adam Rossol's preparations was to meet with Sunrise, he said. They are aware of his plans. Rossol also spread the construction time line into five phases running through 2030. That gives the school division time to prepare.

'The proposed time line over the years of 2023-2030 will allow the school division to react to the enrolment growth at a manageable pace," said Sunrise secretary-treasurer Jody Thiessen.

Thiessen said the proposed development would have the greatest impact on schools in Oakbank and Dugald. Springfield Collegiate has 558 students, while École Dugald sits at 496. Bursting at the seams, Dugald is already uses portable classrooms, with an additional one coming next fall due to enrolment growth.
"The portable arriving in

the fall of 2024 is not related to the proposed subdivision, but due to growing numbers already," Thiessen added. "The trend met the province's standards for granting the division a portable."

Should the new development be approved, it will add to enrolment, Thiessen said. Additional portable classrooms may be an option in the short term. She added Sunrise could also request another addition to École Dugald or another school to be built in Oakbank or Dugald.

Springfield Collegiate has room for growth, Thiessen noted, but it's not limitless.

"If the communities of Dugald and Oakbank experience rapid growth, an option of a portable classroom or classrooms would be a consideration," Thiessen concluded.
