

Scoring System in use at Zone/Area Council Communications

- **Number of Judges:**
 - There are three (or possibly only two) judges for each category.
- **Evaluation Process:**
 - Each judge evaluates each speaker in the category.
 - Another category may be happening concurrently in the session you are judging, allowing time between each competitor to complete the scorecard and/or comment sheet.
- **Timekeeping:**
 - A timekeeper will time all speeches or presentations and provide that information to the judges before rankings are given.
- **Ranking Process:**
 - After all speakers in a category have presented, judges have time to rank the speakers individually and record these on the placing sheets.
 - These placings are collected by the chairperson or timekeeper, who totals the points.
- **Points System:**
 - Points are awarded as follows:
 - 1st = 11 points
 - 2nd = 6 points
 - 3rd = 4 points
- **Tie-breaking:**
 - In the case of a tie, judges are called back, and a process is put in place to break the tie.
- **Tabulation:**
 - The tabulation sheets for the competition are given to the event coordinator for the announcement of winners.
- **Judge's Comment Sheets:**
 - Judge's Comment Sheets will be distributed to competitors.
