Scoring System in use at Zone/Area Council Communications

• Number of Judges:

o There are three (or possibly only two) judges for each category.

Evaluation Process:

- o Each judge evaluates each speaker in the category.
- Another category may be happening concurrently in the session you are judging, allowing time between each competitor to complete the scorecard and/or comment sheet.

• Timekeeping:

o A timekeeper will time all speeches or presentations and provide that information to the judges before rankings are given.

Ranking Process:

- After all speakers in a category have presented, judges have time to rank the speakers individually and record these on the placing sheets.
- These placings are collected by the chairperson or timekeeper, who totals the points.

Points System:

- o Points are awarded as follows:
 - \circ 1st = 11 points
 - \circ 2nd = 6 points
 - \circ 3rd = 4 points

Tie-breaking:

o In the case of a tie, judges are called back, and a process is put in place to break the tie.

• Tabulation:

o The tabulation sheets for the competition are given to the event coordinator for the announcement of winners.

Judge's Comment Sheets:

o Judge's Comment Sheets will be distributed to competitors.
