Who Can Participate

This opportunity is open to all 4-H Manitoba members aged 6-25 years, either individually or as a club.

How to Participate

- Members draw or paint a picture about some part of their life which is important to them to create a “visual letter”.
- Complete the name label and attach it to the back of the picture (copy-ready name label attached).
- Complete the story label and attach it to the back of the picture (copy-ready story label attached). This story will help the youth receiving the artwork better understand what the picture means to the artist.
- Have a parent or guardian complete the Authorization Form.
- Enclose a small photograph of the artist (if permitted)
- Submit art, with completed art labels, signed Parent/Guardian Authorization Form and photograph (if permitted) to:

Artwork Rules

- Submit two-dimensional art only.
- Art paper size should be between 11" x 14" and 12" x 15".
- Do not mount or laminate artwork.
- Completed name and story labels must be attached firmly to the back of the picture.

What Happens Next

- **April 2026:** Artwork will be packaged and sent to partner countries.
- **July 2026:** Artwork kits will be received from partner countries.
- **August 2026:** Incoming artwork will be displayed provincially and/or available for participating clubs to display/review.
- **September 2026:** Web exhibit of the youth's artwork on participating 4-H websites. Pieces of the artwork will be shared with participating clubs.
